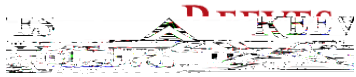
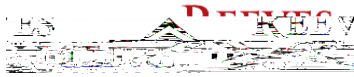


International Student Safe Travel, Arrival and Quarantine Guide

Reeves College's first priority is the health and safety of our students. We are also obligated to follow the regulations and recommendations of various authorities, including the Government of Canada, and the Provincial Government and City public health authorities. The Government of Canada has put in place an emergency order under the Quarantine Act. It applies to all travelers arriving in Canada. Its purpose is to slow the spread of COVID-19 in Canada. Failure to comply with this order is an offence under the Quarantine Act with a maximum penalty including a fine of up to \$750,000 and/or imprisonment up to six months.

As of October 20, 2020, some designated learning institutions (DLIs) are now able to reopen to





Travellers must present proof of having reserved and pre-paid for their accommodation through ArriveCAN. Travellers will still be required to complete the remainder of the mandatory 14-day quarantine after their mandatory hotel stopover.

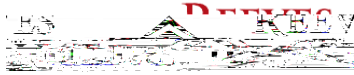
Checklist:

1. Check travel regulations and restrictions
2. Ensure proper supporting documentation and medical coverage
3. Arrange the most direct route to Vancouver
4. Develop a 14-day COVID-19 Self-isolation plan
5. Arrange Self-isolation accommodation
6. Arrange Hotel booking to await COVID-19 test taken at port-of-entry in Canada at [Designated Hotel listed in Government of Canada Website](#)
7. Arrange direct transportation to your place of self-isolation
8. Arrange Food, groceries and other personal items
9. Submit your information through the [ArriveCAN app](#), and conduct a health self-assessment before you depart here: <https://myhealth.alberta.ca/journey/covid-19/Pages/COVID-Self-Assessment.aspx>
10. Register your complete plans with CDI College to travel.support@campus-support.ca
11. Complete a COVID-19 test- either a molecular polymerase chain reaction (PCR) or Loop-mediated Isothermal Amplification (LAMP)–and must be conducted within 72 hours of the traveller’s scheduled departure to Canada.

Complete, initial and sign the International Student Safe Travel and Quarantine Attestation. Submit it to travel.support@campus-support.ca to receive your Travel Support letter.

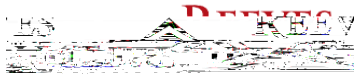
- Bring a copy with you in your carry-on luggage and provide a copy to your College prior to departure.

The travel support letter will only be issued upon receipt of the signed quarantine plan document (International Student Safe Travel and Quarantine Attestation).

Purchase private medical insurance for the first period of stay in Canada until the student is eligible for the provincial medical coverage. If you do not have a private medical insurer, please visit Stay Insured below:

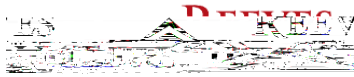
